Do not lose your temper or take the laws into your own hands.
Do not over-react to fouls committed against you.
Do not get involved in matters that do not concern you.
Do not attempt to get opponents into trouble or appeal unnecessarily.



Adult / Supporter Code of Conduct



Young people are not playing to satisfy your ambitions.
Young people are involved for their enjoyment - not yours.
We all have a responsibility to encourage our young people to play by the rules.
Teamwork and effort are just as important as winning, you should accept losing without undue disappointment.
Do not allow your winning side to gloat over their victory.
Never ridicule or shout at a young person for making a mistake or losing. Praise them - or keep quiet!
Remember that children learn best from example, applaud all play.
If you disagree with a match official's decision, raise the issue through the appropriate channels rather than you question the match official's judgment and honesty in public.
Remember that most officials give their time and effort for your child's enjoyment for free.
Never publicly question the referee's decision. No matter how bad they may appear to be.
Show your respect for your team's opponents - without them there would be no game.
Demonstrate appropriate social behaviour by not using foul language, harassing players, coaches or officials.
Help to remove all forms of verbal and physical abuse in soccer.
